

## Description

Analogue outputs module is designed for modulation control of electric actuators in air conditioning, heating and cooling automated systems and process industry. It increases the number of analogue outputs of MR 5000 microprocessor controller and can not be used independently.

Analogue outputs module has 4 analogue outputs (AO) (0 – 10 V DC). Module is hardware addressable. It is possible to connect one module to the main microprocessor controller.

LED indicators on the front module plate show the state of each digital input, as well as power supply presence (ON).

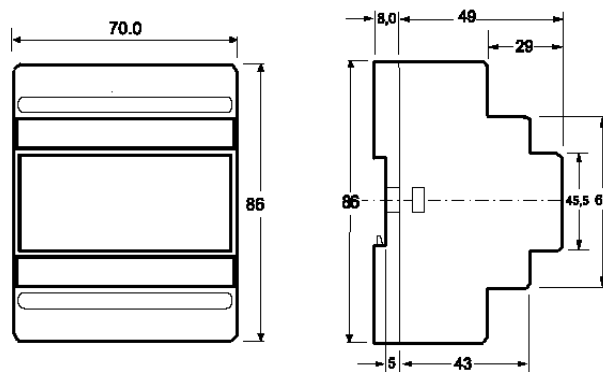

## Design and installation

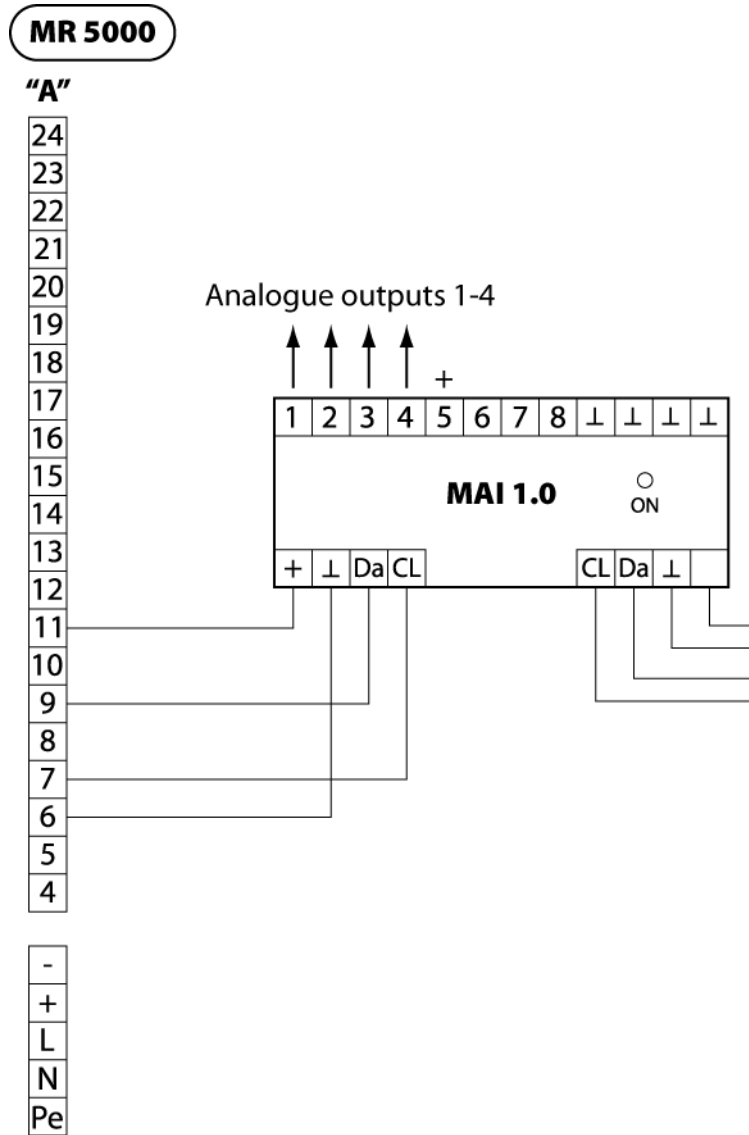
Analogue inputs module is installed on DIN 35 mm rail, according to the following diagram:



Modules are installed side by side near the microprocessor controller unit. Installation order of the modules can be found in the user manual of the appropriate controller.

## Wiring diagram

Connection of the modules with the microprocessor controller is displayed below. The length of conductor from the controller to the module must not exceed 60 cm. Conductors are placed in a rail box separately from energy conductors.
